Garden Produce

1. 5 potatoes any colour
2. 6 pods peas
3. 6 pods runner beans
4. 6 pods French beans
5. 2 beetroots trimmed
6. 3 carrots
7. 3 onions trimmed
8. 6 shallots
9. 2 courgettes
10. Tomatoes 5 fruits shown with calyx
11. A small bowl of mixed salad leaves including herbs and edible flowers
12. Any vegetable not shown in this section, labelled
13. 3 sticks of rhubarb trimmed
14. A plate of fruit any variety
15. 6 hens eggs mixed or single colour from the exhibitor's hens
16. The most impressive vegetable or fruit

Flower Arranging

17. Dartmoor Inspired, an arrangement of flowers and foliage any size, accessories encouraged
18. A display of flowers and grasses in an unusual container, any size
19. A small posy of dried or fresh flowers in a teacup with saucer

Flowers

20. A single bloom – ‘the best from my garden’
21. One hydrangea flowerhead, any cultivar
22. Dahlias, Decorative - a single bloom.
23. Dahlias, Cactus or Semi Cactus, 3 blooms, one colour or mixed.
24. Dahlias, Miniature Ball or Pompom, 5 blooms, one colour or mixed, not exceeding 10cms in diameter.
25. Dahlias, 3 blooms of any cultivar, one type or mixed for example waterlily or collarette, any colour.
26. Cut Flowers – Annuals or herbaceous perennials including roses, a mixed collection of 5 stems
27. Sweet Peas, 9 stems one or mixed varieties
28. Sweet Peas, 3 stems of a single variety
29. Sweet Pea, one stem of any colour to be judged for scent
30. A small vase of sweet peas with 7 stems including a section of the vine with leaves and tendrils

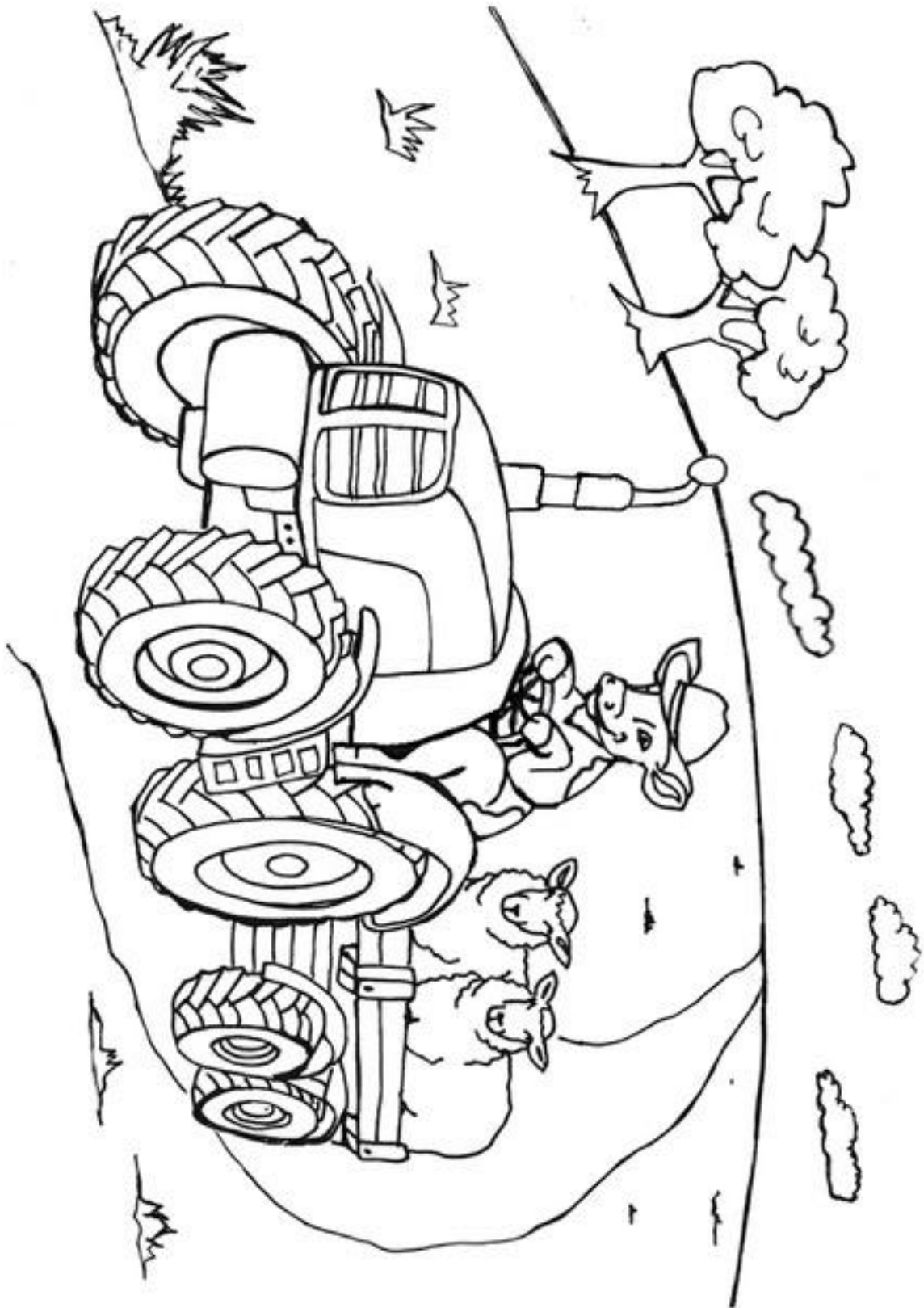

Entry Procedure

Intending exhibitors should submit completed entry forms to the Show Committee at the **Kestor Inn** on **Monday 4th August**, between **7.00pm and 8.00pm** or by email to **entries@manatonshowandfair.co.uk** by midday on **Monday 4th August**.

Each exhibitor will be supplied with a ticket for each of his/her exhibit(s) showing their number and the class number. There will be no charge for entries.

Award of Cups & Plates

The names of winners of the Cups & Plates will be displayed in the Show Tent. Cups and plates will be formally presented at the Manaton Harvest Festival Lunch in the Parish Hall on Sunday October 19th 2025. They may be retained until July 2026.

Cups & Plates

Cups & Plates will be awarded for the most points in the classes below.

1st Prize – 3 points

2nd Prize – 2 points

3rd Prize – 1 point

Only one exhibit per exhibitor can count for points for the award of cups

In the event of a tie (except for all classes aged 16 and under) where more than one class counts towards a cup or plate the judge's decision will be final.

Rules of Entry

All exhibits must be the result of work done by the individual exhibitor except for Class 65 where you are positively encouraged to get together with friends or family and have fun making a wonderful mobile!

All vegetables, fruit and flowers must have been grown by the exhibitor except for Flower Arranging Classes 17, 18 & 19.

Flower arranging classes to be staged using sustainable support materials if required - no floral foam.

Not more than two exhibits in any one class may be entered by any exhibitor.

Exhibitors should mark the back or base of plates, vases, paintings etc with their name.

Children 7 and under may enter any classes in their age category or above, classes 31 to 39 inclusive and more widely, any classes in the show.

Children 12 and under may enter any classes in their age category or above, classes 34 to 39 inclusive and again more widely, any classes in the show.

Teenagers aged 16 and under may enter any classes in the show except for classes 31 – 36 inclusive. Points for entrants between the ages of 13 and 16 will all be counted towards the awarding of The Old Manaton School Handbell.

Art

All artwork in adult classes (bar sculpture) should be capable of being hung or fixed to a vertical board.

Photography

Prints can be in black & white or colour, unframed and either 6 x 4", 7 x 5" or 10 x 8".

Staging of Exhibits and Judging

Staging of all exhibits must be completed by 10 am on the day of the show.

Only officials will be allowed in the show tent from that time until completion of the judging.

The committee will take reasonable care of exhibits but will not be responsible for loss or damage.

The tent should be cleared of all exhibits by 5 pm.
